African American data was also illustrated, as it connects to the Equity Grant. The number of D's and F's in ELA and Social Studies, but decreased in Math and Science.
➤ Morse 2019 Dashboard Data	• Informational: Dr. Larkin, Principal	• Dashboard data is based off of six components. Blue is the highest performance level; Red is the lowest performance level. Our Performance Level in ELA and Math dropped from yellow to orange between 2018 and 2019. Student group reports also breakdown performance level by student demographic. Some student subgroups have dropped, some have made growth.Collectively, Morse has less red in total across subgroups.

We would need to fund .4 FTEs out of Title I. A potential option is to bring back a Dean next year to benefit Morse, especially with issues of truancy. Another option is to have a Network Tech. These will be discussed further for SSCs approval at the next meeting.</li> <li>30100 Basic Program budget still available: \$42,171.36.</li> <li>\$176,875.33 of all Title I monies still available to spend; must spend by end of the school year. Some of the money we have left was slated for AVID tutors, but we have not been able to find any. All departments have been given \$5,000 to spend on instructional materials, subscriptions, and on PD.</li> </ul>
➤ Budget Resource Approval/ Childcare and Translation Services	Informational: Joyce Orona; Other- School Personnel	• Budget Transfer within resource 30103. Dr. Larkin explained that we needed to realign monies within 30103 to cover the negative balances and provide additional monies to cover childcare and translation expenses. Ms. Ornoa made a motion to approve this fund movement and Mrs. Black seconded. The council unanimously approved the budget transfer.
